# **Recipe Sharing**

Some years ago St. Anne's congregation put together a series of recipe books. The earliest before 1992 and the latest in 2012.

Janet thought that you might be interested in one of the recipes devised by her Mum which appeared in the first book:

## Freda's Folly

8oz double cream, whipped

- 1 packet of cookie biscuits and 1 chocolate flake if wanted
- 1 teaspoon coffee mixed in
- 2 tablespoons hot water and 2 tablespoons sherry.
- Dip each biscuit in the coffee mixture fairly quickly.
- Join each biscuit with a little cream to the next biscuit, standing them on edge until a roll shape is achieved.
- Cover all of the biscuits with the whipped double cream. This can be sprinkled with crushed flake chocolate.
- Leave for about 2 hours before eating.
