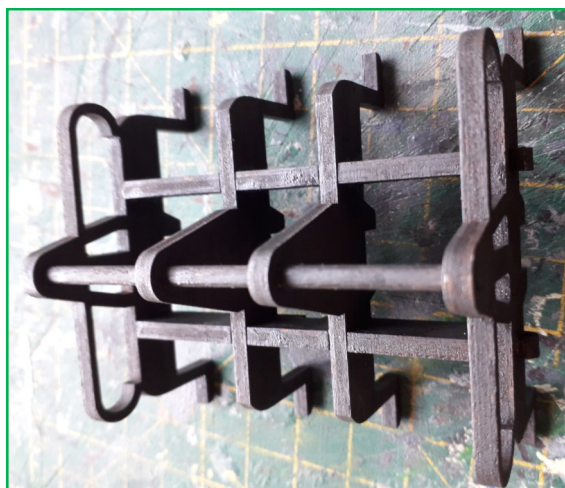
News of the Congregation
