Stephen's sermon (Acts 7 2-53) was a masterpiece of theology, courage, understanding and love. That it failed to convince his listeners was no fault of his. Their judgement was as wrong as it had been at Jesus' own trial.

But Stephen's words have outlived his persecutors, even as the words of Jesus outlived Caiaphas and Pilate.
