We Say Sorry To God

The summary of the law:

Our Lord Jesus Christ said: The first commandment is this: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God is the only Lord. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

The Eucharistic Prayer

please sit or kneel

The Lord is here.

All His Spirit is with us.



Lift up your hearts.

All We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All It is right to give thanks and praise.

It is right to praise you, Father, Lord of all creation;
in your love you made us for yourself.

When we turned away you did not reject us,
but came to meet us in your Son.

**All You embraced us as your children
and welcomed us to sit and eat with you.**

In Christ you shared our life
that we might live in him and he in us.

**All He opened his arms of love upon the
cross and made for all the perfect
sacrifice for sin.**

Together we hold up our pieces of bread

On the night he was betrayed, at supper with his
friends he took bread, and gave you thanks;
he broke it and gave it to them, saying:
Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you;
do this in remembrance of me.

**All Father, we do this in remembrance of
him: his body is the bread of life.**

At the end of supper, taking the cup of wine,
he gave you thanks, and said:
Drink this, all of you; this is my blood of the new
covenant, which is shed for you for the forgiveness
of sins; do this in remembrance of me.

**All Father, we do this in remembrance of him:
his blood is shed for all.**

As we proclaim his death and celebrate his rising in glory, send your Holy Spirit that this bread and this wine may be to us the body and blood of your dear Son.

**All As we eat and drink these holy gifts
make us one in Christ, our risen Lord.**

With your whole Church throughout the world we offer you this sacrifice of praise and lift our voice to join the eternal song of heaven:

**All Holy, holy, holy is the Lord;
holy is the Lord God almighty!
Holy, holy, holy is the Lord;
holy is the Lord God almighty,
who was, and is, and is to come!
Holy, holy, holy is the Lord!**

The Lord's prayer

As our Saviour taught us, so we pray

**All Our Father in heaven,
hallowed be your name,
your kingdom come, your will be done,
on earth as in heaven.**



**Give us today our daily bread.
Forgive us our sins as we forgive those
who sin against us.
Lead us not into temptation but deliver

Breaking of the Bread

We break this bread to share in the body of Christ.

Jesus, redeemer of the world, grant us
peace.**



Sharing of Communion

Draw near with faith. Receive the body of our Lord Jesus Christ which he gave for you.

Together we eat our pieces of bread

Eat in remembrance that he died for you, and feed on him in your hearts by faith with thanksgiving.

We Say Thank You to God

All Almighty God, we thank you for feeding us with the body and blood of your Son Jesus Christ. Through him we offer you our souls and bodies to be a living sacrifice. Send us out in the power of your Spirit to live and work to your praise and glory. Amen.

We Are Sent to Spread God's word

*Please **stand** if you able to, we say together*

**Heavenly Father We thank you for our friends, homes and families. We ask that your love may surround us, Your care may protect us and that we may know your peace at all times For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ our Lord.
Amen**

The president may use the seasonal blessing, or another suitable blessing, or

The peace of God, which passes all understanding, keep your hearts and minds in the knowledge and love of God, and of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord; and the blessing of God almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, be among you and remain with you always.
